Our aim is to offer, for the sixth time, a stable and suitable meeting point for specialists in broad sense mineral sciences of the Central- and Eastern-European Region. We also welcome colleagues from outside of this region, promoting a wide-ranged European and worldwide scientific collaboration. Scientific programme
